# CREATE AN ALIEN-FRIENDLY ATMOSPHERE!

## SUPER SECRET SIGNAGE

Print and hang the Super Secret party sign (page 6) on the door of your next double-extra confidential, highly classified gathering. Be sure to scrutinize invitations or risk a security breach!

## STARS AND PLANETS

Cut stars of different sizes out of cardboard and cover with aluminum foil. Attach thread, and hang from the ceiling or windows. Planets can be made the same way.

## GHASTLY GLOW

Popping a green light bulb into an ordinary lamp can give any room an eerie glow perfect for monsters or aliens. Or, for a shine that seems out-of-this-world, try other bulb colors such as orange or red.

## ROBOT SPACESHIP

An empty refrigerator box with cut holes, embellished with aluminum foil and colored paper, can easily be transformed into a rocket ship or space robot.



## PARTY PLANNING TIP:

It is colossally easy to throw a Monsters vs Aliens bash thanks to HP's printable **photo invites**, **place cards**, **candy holder favors**, and **thank you cards**. Just print, fold, glue, and you are set.

# PLAY GALACTIC GAMES!



## SCARED SILLY

Lay a white sheet on the floor for kids to lie down on. Spread their hair straight up and out like it is standing on end. Encourage gruesome or frightened facial expressions and snap some pictures. ## EVIL GENIUS' LABORATORY

Kids will enjoy hours of fun concocting potions and making monsters in a makeshift science lab you can easily assemble. Little lab coats and goggles can help set the scene, while plastic test tubes and beakers filled with colored water can create monstrous potions. Petri dishes filled with gelatin and gummy worms make for fun experiments—and snacks.

## CREATE A CODE

Write top-secret messages to your friends or party guests using a secret code you create. Here are some ways to create super secret codes:

- Use symbols that only you and your confidants know in place of the letters of the alphabet. You can use shapes and common symbols or you can create your own. Make sure you give the recipient a symbol sheet to decode the message.
- Write a note with lemon juice and a small paintbrush. Only your trusted friend will know that there is a secret code on the page that he or she can see if the note is held up to a light bulb.
- Write your letters backward or reverse their order. You can also scramble the words and ask the receiver to unscramble your message.



## COLOSSAL CRAFTS

All you need is a printer, some scissors and a little glue, and your kids can create amazing movie-inspired 3-D paper crafts including **Insectosaurus**, a **U.S. tank**, **Alien Miner Robot**, and a **Monsters vs Aliens diorama**. # MAKE MONSTROUS MEALS!

## SCARY SANDWICHES

Create wonderful worm-filled sandwiches by slicing hot dogs into super thin worm-length pieces. Microwave them until they begin to curl. Place lettuce, ketchup, and 4 or 5 worms between two slices of bread, making sure a few look like they are wiggling out the end.



## MAD SCIENTIST'S PUNCH

In a large bowl mix, one part club soda and two parts grape juice. Add peeled grapes as slimy eyeballs, and a few scoops of sherbet just before serving to create a frothy concoction.

## BOB WIGGLERS

In honor of everyone's favorite gelatinous movie character, allow blue gelatin to harden on a cookie sheet. Then use a knife to carve out Bob-shaped pieces. Serve alongside eyeball candies and gummy worms.

## ID BADGE BACKPACK TAGS

Give your kids' backpacks the flair of a secret agent's briefcase with a **shrinkable ID badge**. These make great party favors too.
